RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL POLICY

As a provider of alcohol we recognise that we have a significant legal duty of care, both to the consumer and wider community. This policy aims to provide a basis for the responsible use of alcohol by the Angle Vale Football Club and this is seen as fundamental to the aims of the club.

To ensure that alcohol is managed responsibly by the club and its members, the following requirements will apply when alcohol is served by the club, on or off the club premises.

- We will abide by all the requirements and laws of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1977*. When the bar is open.
- Accompanied underage people are allowed on the premises until 12 midnight.
- In accordance with our licensing provisions, our premises will be personally supervised by an Angle Vale Football Club committee member at all times while the premises are open to the public, and the bar is open.
- We will ensure that all volunteers and staff working behind the bar are given the opportunity, and encouraged to complete Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) training.
- A list of RSA trained people will be displayed behind the bar.
- Information posters about standard drink measures will be displayed in the club rooms.
- An incident register will be maintained and any incidents recorded.
- People under 18 do not serve alcohol.
- We will provide at least 5 options for non-alcoholic drinks and free drinking water.
- No all-you-can-drink or free-drink functions will be organised or held.
- We will provide substantial food when the bar is open for more than 90 minutes, and more than 20 people are present. Examples of substantial food are:
 - Soup
 - Toasted Sandwiches
 - Pies, pasties and sausage rolls
 - Hot dogs, burgers or pizza
 - Hot Chips
 - BBQs
 - Full meal options (e.g. schnitzels, pasta with salad and chips)

- A **Safe Transport Policy** is also current for the AVFC, and free calls to taxis are available.
- A **Smoke Free Policy** is also current for the AVFC, and is reviewed in conjunction with this policy.
- Any person found supplying alcohol to under age people will be asked to immediately leave the premises and the surrounding grounds along with the underage people involved.
- Unattended drinks will be regularly removed from tables and other areas.
- All people purchasing alcohol must be able to produce a valid identification card (with picture and date of birth) on demand.
- The club does not encourage excessive or rapid consumption of alcohol
- Drunk patrons will not be permitted to enter the premises
- Alcohol will not be served to any person intoxicated or drunk.
- The club will minimise the use of alcohol for awards and fundraising prizes.

The AVFC recognises the importance of educating club members, particularly players, about the benefits of an alcohol management policy and will endeavour to provide information to assist this process.

The AVFC will actively participate in the Australian Drug Foundation's Good Sports program with an ongoing priority to achieve Level 3 accreditation.

Non Compliance

All club committee members will enforce the alcohol management policy and any non-compliance, particularly in regard to Licensing Laws will be handled according to the following process:

- Explanation of the club policy to the person/people concerned, including identification of the section of policy not being complied with,
- Continued non-compliance with the policy should be handled by at least two committee members who will use their discretion as to the action taken, which may include asking the person/people to leave the club facilities or function.

Promotion

The club will promote the alcohol management policy regularly by:

- Advertising the policy in club communications such as newsletters, websites and other printer player/member material, and
- Making a copy of the policy available at all times within the club premises.

Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed bi-annually to ensure it remains current, relevant, practical, and that it reflects the community expectations as well as the club's legal requirements.
