SAFE TRANSPORT POLICY

This policy aims to provide a basis for the responsible use and/or non use of alcohol by the Angle Vale Football Club, and aims to avoid any incidents as people travel to or from the club and its events.

The club understands and accepts its responsibility to the safety of our members and visitors. The following requirement will apply when alcohol is served either at the club or during a club function.

- Bar staff shall encourage members and visitors to make alternate safe transport arrangements if they appear intoxicated or are considered to exceed 0.05 blood alcohol concentration.
- Telephone calls will be made free of charge to arrange a taxi or other transport.
- Contact telephone numbers for taxi services will be displayed clearly (AVFC is pre-registered with Adelaide independent Taxis, call 132-211 to access).
- In specific cases, a designated driver who has been nominated by the club and that person has accepted the responsibility to drive others home safely, will be provided non alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club.
- Bar servers will be provided non alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club.
- Where available, club transport will be prearranged to/from events.
- Taxi vouchers will be considered as part of selected raffle prizes/player awards.

POLICY REVIEW

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it remains current, relevant, practical, and that it reflects the community expectations as well as the club's legal requirements.
